I would like to make a suggestion rather than a 'submission' on making Health and Safety in the Workplace for Elected Persons Training more accessible and affordable for 'volunteer/non-profit organizations'. I am a member of two volunteer organizations who wish me to be their Health and Safety in the Workplace Elected Person. Both of these organizations are registered with the Charities Commission and Incorporated Societies : "Cats Protection League (Wellington) Inc." and the "Wellington South Community Patrol" which is part of Community Patrols NZ under the auspices of NZ Police.

Of the few providers in the Wellington area offering the 2 day courses for H & S in the Workplace, they are priced at \$1000.00 plus which I believe deters many people from undertaking this training.

I would like to see consideration given to this during the consultation process.
